RAOB User Hint. Did you know that you can Zoom-in on the Cross-Section diagrams? Just hold down the CTRL Key and click & drag the mouse over the diagram, which will display a rubber-band outline of the selected area. Upon mouse release, the cross-section will be re-drawn to the selected area. You will also then be able to save the resized dataset to a new datafile.
