RAOB 6.8 Beta program. The RAOB 6.8 Beta program is now under development. New advancements include expansion of the ACARS/AMDAR decoders, and an optional 'wind direction' filter to allow fine tuning of the 'Dust Storm' potential indicator. If you have made a RAOB 6.7 purchase, you are eligible to use the 6.8 Beta program now since you will be eligible for this free upgrade when RAOB 6.8 is released later this year.
