

The RAOB Annual Awards are given to individuals who make significant contributions to the advancement of the RAOB Program through suggested additions and new functions. Each winner receives a new 2018 RAOB Bundled Package.

<u>1st Place Winner: Andy Devanas</u> Science and Operations Officer (SOO) at NWS Key West, Florida.

Andy wins the RAOB "Complete" program package. He developed the Key West (NWS) Florida waterspout probability estimate index (RAOB Index: Waterspout3).

2nd Place Winner: Timothy Mathewson RMA Fire Weather Program Manager and BLM Fire Meteorologist-Incident Meteorologist, Lakewood, CO.

Tim wins the RAOB "Operational" program package. He recommended expansion and standardization of PBL (Mixing Height) methodologies, including the addition of a user-configurable VAR (Ventilation Adjective Rating) system.

<u>3rd Place Winner: Gilbert Christoffel</u> Aeronautical forecaster and warning supervisor, MeteoLux, Luxembourg.

Gilbert wins the RAOB "Forecaster" program package. He suggested inclusion of the "Thermal Wind" profile option on the Sounding Toolbar and with the Fronts & Forecast module.
